

Fifth International Youth Forum

22-23 August 2025 Bangkok, Thailand

Concept Note

I. Background

The **International Youth Forum (IYF)** is a globally recognized, inclusive platform that engages young leaders, policymakers, civil society actors, and international organizations in advancing the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Since its inception in 2017, the forum has evolved into a dynamic space for dialogue, collaboration, and youth-led action, supporting the implementation and review of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) from the perspective of young people.

Held annually, the forum empowers youth—particularly from marginalized and underrepresented communities—to influence policies, share innovations, and strengthen accountability for sustainable development and human rights. It brings together delegates from over 90 countries, including youth activists, ministers, UN officials, ambassadors, educators, and civil society leaders, who collectively contribute to shaping global and national development agendas.

The **5th International Youth Forum (IYF 5.0)** will take place under the theme: **"Empowering Youth for a Just, Inclusive and Sustainable Future"**, convening from 21-22 August 2025 at the **United Nations Conference Centre (UNCC)** in **Bangkok, Thailand**. Aligned with the priorities of the 2030 Agenda and key global forums such as the Second World Summit for Social Development and High Level Political Forum, IYF 5.0 will feature interactive plenaries, skill-building workshops, policy dialogues, and networking opportunities focused on accelerating youth participation and leadership in achieving the SDGs. IYF 5.0 will assess youth engagement and solutions in advancing the following SDGs under review in 2025: SDG 3 – Good Health and Well-being, SDG 5 – Gender Equality, SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth, SDG 14 – Life Below Water, SDG 17 – Partnerships for the Goals.

The forum will also serve as a platform for sharing youth-led solutions, building cross-sectoral partnerships, and preparing recommendations that reflect the aspirations and insights of the world's young population. Through this collective engagement, IYF continues to ensure that youth voices are central to global development conversations and that no one is left behind.

One of the key outcomes of IYF 5.0 will be the Youth Declaration and Call to Action-a collective policy document shaped by participants to reflect their shared vision and priorities. In recognition of exceptional impact, the Global SDG Awards will honor outstanding youth-led initiatives driving positive change in their communities.
